Check for breathing. If they are not breathing, start CPR. Perform 30 chest compressions. Perform two rescue breaths. Repeat until an ambulance or automated external defibrillator (AED) arrives ...

How to perform CPR: Guidelines, procedure, and ratio

Place your hands, one on top of the other, in the middle of the chest. Use your body weight to help you administer compressions that are at least 2 inches deep and delivered at a rate of at least 100 compressions per minute. 2. Deliver rescue breaths.

Rooted Mama Health explains that if the victim is non-responsive and does not appear to be breathing, begin CPR: Compressions – 30 compressions at 2 inches deep, 100 per minute. If the rescuer is trained in CPR, they should give 2 rescue breaths, otherwise, continue with compressions

In Pediatric Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers (HCP), the rescuer should first determine quickly if the victim is unresponsive. The provider should note if the victim is not breathing or is only gasping.
