This guidance examined the evidence behind non-pharmacological therapies. These therapies fall into two main areas — the first considers interventions for cognitive symptoms and maintaining function, while the second looks at interventions for non-cognitive symptoms and challenging behaviour (or 'behaviour that challenges').

Conclusions In contrast to pharmacological treatments, the majority of non-pharmacological interventions for treating patients with MDD are not evidence based. For patients with strong preferences against pharmacological treatments, clinicians should focus on therapies that have been compared directly with antidepressants.

Pharmacological and non-pharmacological treatments for ...

Non-pharmacological interventions should become increasingly focused on the individual as patients mature and become 'agents of implementation' in their care. 8 Psychosocial interventions play a particularly important role during key life transitions, e.g. the transition between adolescence and adulthood. 9 Treatments should be modified for key developmental stages, reflecting both the most problematic behavioural symptoms at that stage in time, and the patient's level of understanding. 8

Alternative non-pharmacological therapies As in other areas of health care, alternative therapies are gaining currency in the treatment of people with dementia. These therapies often still lack empirical evidence relating to their effectiveness (Marshall & Hutchinson, 2001), but this issue is gradually being addressed.

Non-pharmacological interventions in dementia

The review also indicates that patient education is critical in the early stages of care, and that weight loss and exercise are key to any nonpharmacological treatment. The guidelines are expanded for practical implementation of evidence-based, conservative management of hip and knee osteoarthritis.
