Historic Coupar Angus Scottish Burgh

Visitors approaching historical Coupar Angus from the north, cross the river Isla at the Couttie Bridge, built around 1766. The majority of Scottish medieval towns and early modern towns have an axial main street with back lanes running parallel and plots set in a herring-bone pattern from the main street. The radial pattern of Coupar Angus streets from the market cross was therefore unusual, although not unique.

Historical Coupar Angus - Perthshire Scottish Highlands

By the time of the Reformation, Coupar Angus was said to be the wealthiest Cistercian Abbey in Scotland. Townships grew up next to Cistercian Abbeys. A small medieval settlement was situated by the Coupar Burn and in Abbey times a market was held every Friday at the Market Cross. The market cross was a focus marking the centre of the Burgh of Barony.
