THE EPIPELAGIC OR THE SUNLIGHT ZONE • Epipelagic or the Sunlight Zone- The very first layer is most commonly called the Sunlight zone but its scientific name is the Epipelagic Zone. This zone starts at the surface of the sea and extends 656 feet deep (200 meters).
