We find that neighborhoods matter more for boys than girls: the signal standard deviation of county-level effects is roughly 60% larger for boys than girls in low-income (25th percentile) families. The distribution has an especially thick lower tail for boys, as counties with high concentrations of urban poverty such as Baltimore City and Wayne County (Detroit) produce especially negative outcomes for boys. 6

The neighbourhood effect is an economic and social science concept that posits that neighbourhoods have either a direct or indirect effect on individual behaviors. Although the effect of the neighbourhood was already known and studied at the beginning of the 20th century and as early as the mid 19th century, it has become a popular approach after the publication of the book The Truly Disadvantaged by William Julius Wilson in 1987. Our neighborhoods are highly correlated with the quality of our housing, municipal services, health care and educational and employment opportunities, which can have a significant impact on our health. Depending on where we live, our health may be adversely affected by neighborhood characteristics such as poor air and water quality, proximity to hazardous substances, substandard housing, and lack of access to nutritious foods and safe places to exercise or play.

As protective measures such as unemployment insurance payments and eviction moratoriums expire, economic impacts in neighborhoods could lead to an unparalleled number of evictions. Between February and April of 2020, Indiana lost 436,000 jobs, driving the unemployment rate from 3.1% to 17.5%.

The impacts of police violence can extend beyond the direct victims to nearby high school students. Students who live close to a police killing during high school are estimated to be 2.5% less likely to graduate from high school and 2% less likely to enroll in college than students from the same neighborhood who live farther from the shooting.

According to the examination on the effect of spatial scale, the capability for a neighborhood green space to attenuate PM 2.5 pollution would be vanished when its size smaller than 200 m, and would be maximized when its size within 400–500 m.
